Horses and Ponies may enter no more than 7 classes over fences, including equitation and all special classes such as classics. Riders may be disqualified due to acts of discourtesy toward officials. Management may restrict the courtesy circle with a mandatory dotted line. The three-minute rule may be put in effect at any time upon announcement. Hunter courses shall simulate obstacles found in the hunt field, such as natural rails, gates, walls, etc. Proper attire is required in all classes except warm-up, when chaps or other non-standard attire may be worn. Schooling on the flat and over fences will be available on both days from 7am - 8am. All courses will be set on a 12' stride. Helmets must be worn while mounted at all times. All riders must wear ASTM-SEI approved helmets with a properly-adjusted (snug) harness. No junior will be allowed to ride stallions. All dogs must be on a leash of no more than 6 feet in length, or otherwise contained, at all times while on competition grounds. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Loose and/or disruptive dogs may be subject to impoundment by the horse show or by the local government. Owners of loose and/or disruptive dogs may be subject to penalties and/or fines under GHJA Rules 18 and 19. Warning cards may be issued to such dog owners, an accumulation of which shall result in further penalties. Unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds. Failure to abide by these regulations will subject the exhibitor to suspension from the horse show. Please refer to USEF GR 1301.7. **ALL ENTRY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED BY EVERY ADULT - COMPETITOR, PARENT AND/OR TRAINER.**

Points will be awarded as follows:

10 points for first place 6 points for second place 4 points for third place
 2 points for fourth place 1 point for fifth place .5 points for sixth place
 20 points for Champion* 12 points for Reserve Champion*

**In case of a tie for Champion or Reserve Champion, award will go to the rider with the most points over fences. Only top 4 over fences are eligible for Champion and Reserve Champion. Points for the year end awards will accumulate from riders' date of membership. Limited eligibility decisions will be made by the SHJG Board of Directors. Ribbons will be given to 1st - 6th place, and Champion and Reserve Champion will receive a ribbon and an award.*

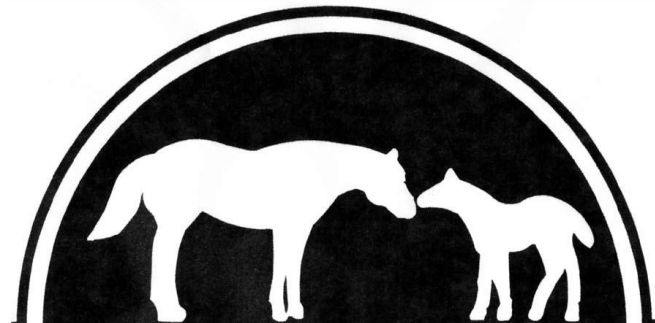

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

PLEASURE HORSE/PONY: Judged on suitability as a pleasure mount.

HUNTER HACK 2' - Judged on the flat and two fences. Open to all horses and riders.

GREEN HUNTER 2': Open to all horses in their first 2 years of showing.

LOW HUNTER 2' - Open to all horses and riders.

SCHOOLING HUNTER 2'3 - Open to all horses and riders.

LEAD LINE - Open to beginner riders on horses led by a helper. Riders may not show in any other classes other than Walk/Halt. (Entry fee \$5.00)

MODEL: Judged on conformation and way of going.

SHOWMANSHIP: Judged on the handlers ability to show horse in hand to its best advantage; and on the handler. Pattern will be determined by the judge.

JR. PRE-BEGINNER DIVISION - Limited to riders in their first two years of showing who are 12 and under as of 12/1/11. Division: walk/halt equitation class, walk/trot equitation class, walk/trot pleasure class (judged on suitability of horse as a beginner mount, not judged on movement of horse). Riders in this division may not ride in any Jr. Beginner classes.

BEGINNER GROUNDRAILS DIVISION - Limited to riders in their first two years of showing who are 12 and under as of 12/1/11; consisting of the following three classes: ground rails one around, ground rails twice around and walk/trot/canter one-at-a-time. Riders may either ride in Jr. Pre-Beginner Flat Division or Jr. Beginner Flat Division, but not both.

JR. / ADULT BEGINNER FLAT DIVISION - Riders must be in their first two years of showing. Riders may ride in Ground Poles or Jr. Beginner Crossrail division, but not both. Riders may not ride in Pre-Beginner, Crossrail Hunter, or Mini Hunter Divisions. Division consists of an equitation class, a pleasure class (judged on suitability of horse as a beginner mount, not judged on movement of horse), and a canter one at a time class (riders will walk/trot together). Jr. Beginner riders must be 12 or younger as of 12/1/11, Adult Beginner riders are 13 or over as of 12/1/11. Classes will be split if more than 3 entries in each division.

JR. / ADULT BEGINNER CROSSRAIL DIVISION - Riders may not enter Pre-beginner division. Riders may enter Jr. Beginner Flat Division or Crossrail Hunter Division, but not both. Riders are not penalized for trotting in jumping classes. One around and twice around in opposite directions. Jr. Beginner riders must be 12 or younger as of 12/1/11, Adult Beginner riders are 13 or over as of 12/1/11. Classes will be split if more than 3 entries in each division.

CROSSRAIL HUNTER DIVISION - Open to horses in their first two years of showing or riders in their first two years of showing, not including beginner years. Horse/rider combination may only cross enter into Mini Hunter OR Jr./Adult Beginner Crossrails (but not the Jr./Adult Beginner Flat division).

MINI-HUNTER 18"- 2' DIVISION - Open to all horses in their first two years of showing OR riders in their first two years of showing, not including beginner years. Horse/rider combination may only cross enter into Crossrail Hunter division.

SHJG MEDALS QUALIFICATION

SHJG MEDALS: Fences 2' or 2'6". Must be SHJG member and not have won a SHJG medal final in the past 3 years. Medal classes are open to all riders to be shown over a modified jumper type course of at least eight fences. O/F will count for 75%, flat will count 25%. Riders must earn one blue ribbon or 12 points to qualify for the year-end medal finals class.

- **HORSE POWER MEDAL FOR JUNIORS ON PONIES 2' or 2'6"** - Juniors on ponies.
- **SOUTHERN CHARM MEDAL FOR JUNIORS ON HORSES:** Juniors on horses.
- **HARBIN AGENCY ADULT MEDAL 2' or 2'6"** - Riders 18 & over, on horses or ponies.

GHJA Jr. Equitation Challenge

Open to GHJA Junior & Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Judged at walk, trot, & canter. Will be asked to perform at least 2 of the following USEF tests at Judge's Discretion: #1 Halt; #2 Hand Gallop; #9 Ride without Stirrups; #15 Change Leads on a line showing simple or flying change; #17 Counter Canter. Martingales not permitted. No outside assistance of coaching. Winners of the final Jr. EQ Challenge in 2009-2011 not eligible. November 1st in deadline for qualifying.

GHJA LOCAL SANCTIONED CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

This SHJG Horse Show is a Local Member Show of Georgia Hunter Jumper Association, Inc. and is operated in accordance with current rules of GHJA. Every person who participates in the show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to GHJA rules. The following divisions are recognized by GHJA and points won will count toward end of year high score awards:

14.1.1.1. Short Stirrup Hunter: Open to riders ages 12 years and under, on horses or ponies, in their first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18" in any hunter show. **NOTE:** Participation in once around-twice around or beginner and crossrail classes will not count as part of these two years as long as the jump height does not exceed 18". A rider on a pony may cross-enter only into Schooling Pony (2' only) and age group equitation, not to include any medal classes. A rider on a horse may cross-enter only into Pre-Children's (2'6" only) and age group equitation, not to include any medal classes. Riders may enter non-recognized classes where fence heights do not exceed 2' for ponies and 2'6" for horses. Riders may not enter "under saddle" or "flat" classes that do not fall within these parameters.

14.1.1.2. Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to qualified Short Stirrup riders. Fence height 2'.

14.1.1.3. Schooling Pony: 2' or 2'6". May jump either height at the rider's or trainer's discretion. Open to Junior riders only.

14.1.1.4. Small Pony Hunter: 2' (ponies not to exceed 12.2 hh) Open to Junior riders 12 years of age or under. **14.1.1.5. Medium Pony Hunter:** 2'3" (ponies over 12.2 hh, but not to exceed 13.2 hh) Open to Junior riders 14 years of age or under. **14.1.1.6. Large Pony Hunter:** 2'9" (ponies over 13.2 hh, but not to exceed 14.2 hh). See Rule 12.3.12 for Under Saddle guidelines.

14.1.1.7. Long Stirrup Hunter: Open to Amateur and Junior riders, 13 years of age and older, on horses or ponies in their first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18" in any hunter show. **NOTE:** Participation in once around-twice around or beginner and crossrail classes will not count as part of these two years as long as the jump height does not exceed 18". Adult riders who are re-entering the show ring after an absence cannot have shown over fences higher than 2'6" in the past 5 years. Riders may compete in this division no more than two consecutive years. The two years of long stirrup eligibility are continuous show calendar years that cannot be separated or divided in any manner. A rider may cross enter only into Hunter divisions and age group equitation at the same show if fence height does not exceed 2'6", not to include any medal classes. Riders may enter non-recognized classes where fence heights do not exceed 2'6". Riders may not enter "under saddle" or "flat" classes that do not fall within these parameters.

14.1.1.8. Long Stirrup Equit.: Open to qualified Long Stirrup Riders. Fence height 2'3".

14.1.1.9. Pre-Children's Hunter: Open to Junior riders on horses or ponies; horse/rider combination may not have competed at 3'3" or higher at any Local or Regular Member horse show in the previous 3 years. Fence height 2'6".

14.1.1.10. Pre-Adult Hunter: Open to Adult Amateur riders on horse or ponies; horse/rider combination may not have competed at 3'3" or higher at any Local or Regular Member horse show in the previous 3 years. Fence height 2'6".

14.1.1.11. Modified Hunter: Open to all horses or ponies ridden by juniors, amateurs or professionals. Fence height 2'9"

14.1.1.12. Open Hunter: 2'6" or 3' (horse or pony). Rider may show in either height group at rider's or trainer's discretion.

14.1.1.13. Adult Amateur Hunter: 3'. Open to Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. A pony ridden in the Adult Amateur Hunters may not cross enter into any Pony Hunter division or Junior Equitation division or Junior Medal at the same show.

14.1.1.14. Children's Hunter: 3'. Open to all horses ridden by a Junior.

14.1.1.15. Junior/Amateur Hunter: 3'3". Open to all horses ridden by a Junior or an Amateur.

14.1.1.18. Equitation 11 and under: 2'. No straight lines may be set at less than 60'.

14.1.1.19. Equitation 12 to 14: 2'6". No straight lines may be set at less than 60'.

14.1.1.20. Equitation 15 to 17: 3'

14.1.1.21. Adult Amateur Equitation: 3'

GHJA MEDALS QUALIFICATIONS

14.1.1.22. GHJA Pony Medal: Small 2', Medium 2'3", Large 2'9" (see Rule 15 for detailed specifications) Small to be ridden by Junior riders 12 years of age or under; Medium to be ridden by Junior riders 14 years of age or under.

14.1.1.23. J.D. Pounds Junior Medal: 3' (see Rule 15 for detailed specifications)

14.1.1.24. GHJA Adult Medal: 3' (see Rule 15 for detailed specifications)

14.1.1.25. Low Schooling Jumper: under 3'6"

14.1.1.26. High Schooling Jumper: 3'6" and higher

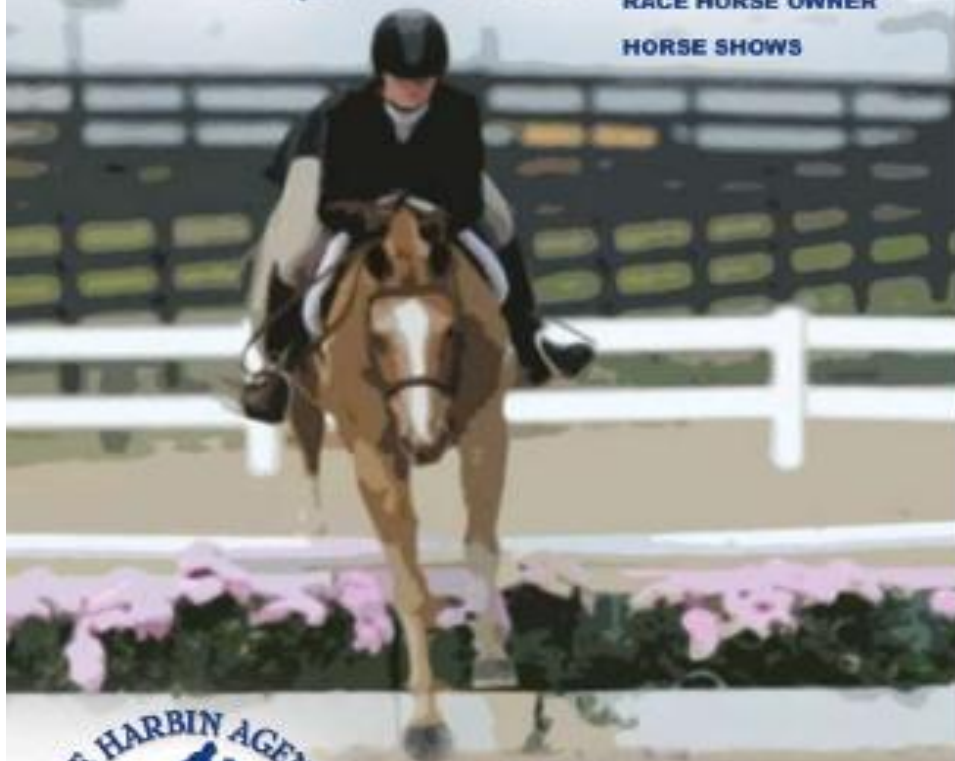

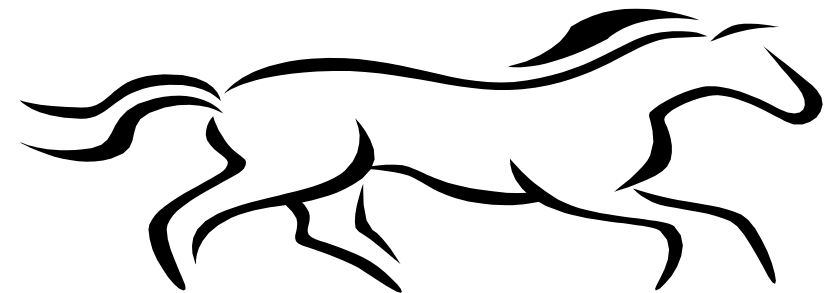
