Directions to the show:

I-85 to Exit 61 (Hwy 74). Proceed south on Hwy 74. Travel about 4.8 miles to Tyrone Road and turn left. Take Tyrone Road for 3.5 miles to stop sign at Flat Creek Trail—turn right onto Flat Creek Trail and travel to next stop sign (Hwy 54). Turn right onto Hwy 54. At the next light turn left (Ebenezer Rd). Farm is 0.8 miles on the right. .

SHJG General Specifications

- Show management, their employees and officials shall not be responsible for any accident or injury which might occur to persons, horses or to any property while attending the shows, nor will they be responsible for any personal article which may be lost, stolen or destroyed.
- Schooling is only permitted in the show rings at specified times. Warm-up rings are available; horses may not be turned loose in the rings. A \$100.00 fine will be levied for any unauthorized schooling over show fences.
- **BACK TO SCHOOL** is a Local Member Show of the Southern Hunter Jumper of Georgia Association, Inc. and is operated in accordance with the current rules of SHJG. Every person who participates in the show is responsible for a knowledge of, and is subject to the rules of the SHJG. Members receive or have access to a copy of the current rule book of the SHJG at www.shjgonline.com. No points will count toward Annual Awards before membership dues have been paid and horse is registered with the SHJG
- Proper attire is encouraged, however, solid color polo shirts, jods/breeches with appropriate footwear is acceptable and will not be penalized.
- Protective A.S.T.M./S.E.I approved Headgear is mandatory at all times when mounted. Chin straps must be snug.
- Classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted.
- **Horses and ponies may enter no more than seven “over fences” classes, no more than five of which can be Jumper classes, on a single show day. All warm-up trips and special classes, such as equitation medals, hunter classics, derbies, and stakes classes are included in this total. All Jumper classics, stakes, warm-ups, and clear round classes shall count towards the limit of five Jumper classes. *New for 2019***
- Questions not covered by SHJG rules will be decided by the horse show management; such decision shall be final.
- Minor exhibitors—Parents or guardians shall hold the management, staff, and facility of the horse show harmless for any injury to such minor. A minor’s entry will only be accepted when it is signed by a parent or guardian.
- Unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate motorized vehicles of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds. Failure to abide by these regulations will subject the exhibitor to suspension from the horse show.
- The courtesy circle may be restricted by a mandatory dotted line which will be indicated on the course diagram.
- In classes with a posted order of go, the 1 minute rule will be in effect. The 3 minute rule will be in effect for all other classes.
- Flat classes will not be delayed for trainer conflict. A ring will not be held more than 5 minutes for a conflict between 2 over-fences classes. Gatekeepers are authorized to drop late riders to the end of the jumping order or to scratch riders who do not enter a ring in a timely manner, with no refund to exhibitors. Please plan classes accordingly and notify the gatekeepers of legitimate ring conflicts between over fences classes so that a compatible order can be established. It is recommended that trainers have an assistant available if a conflict is anticipated.

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER - fence height 2' with no oxers. Open to junior riders 12 and under as of December 1, 2020 in their first two years out of the beginner ring. Riders may ride in the Short Stirrup division for two consecutive years OR one year of Short Stirrup and one year of Long Stirrup if the rider ages out of Short Stirrup after the first year.

LONG STIRRUP HUNTER - fence height 2'3" with no oxers. Open to junior riders 13 and over as of December 1, 2020 and adult amateur riders in their first two years of showing out of the beginner ring. Riders may ride in the Long Stirrup division for two consecutive years OR one year of Short Stirrup and one year of Long Stirrup if the rider ages out of Short Stirrup after the first year.

LIMIT EQUITATION (Crossrails or 18") - open to riders in the beginner ring competing in Beginner Crossrails and higher. Fence height to be determined by trainer. Simple lead changes will not be penalized. Riders may cross-enter into the Crossrail Equitation Medal.

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION - open to riders eligible to compete in the Short Stirrup Hunter division.

LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION - open to riders eligible to compete in the Long Stirrup Hunter division.

BEGINNER WALK/TROT EQUITATION CHALLENGE - open to beginner riders who are not yet showing in classes that are cantering as a group. This will be judged as an equitation class. Riders may be asked to sit the trot as well as demonstrate the 2-point position. If the rider has won this equitation challenge at the 2020 SHJG Fall Finale show, he/she may no longer compete in this challenge regardless of eligibility in the other divisions.

BEGINNER W/T/C/ EQUITATION CHALLENGE - open to beginner riders who are showing in classes that are cantering as a group. This will be judged as an equitation class. Riders may be asked to sit the trot as well as demonstrate the 2-point position. If the rider has won this equitation challenge at the 2020 SHJG Fall Finale horse show, he/she may no longer compete in this challenge regardless of eligibility in the other divisions.

SHJG EQUITATION CHALLENGE - open to all riders who are showing at the 2' or higher fence heights. This will be judged as an equitation class. Riders may be asked to halt, back, ride without stirrups, sit the trot, perform simple changes of lead during a change of direction, counter canter, or demonstrate changes of lead on a line. Riders may also be asked to demonstrate lengthening and shortening of stride at the trot. If the rider has won this equitation challenge at the 2020 SHJG Fall Finale horse show, he/she may not compete in this challenge for 3 years (2021, 2022, 2023).

SHJG CROSSRAIL EQUITATION MEDAL - open to riders in the beginner ring competing in the Beginner Crossrails and/or Crossrail Hunter & Mini Hunter divisions. Simple lead changes will not be penalized. Riders may trot and/or canter the course. If the rider has won this equitation medal at the 2020 SHJG Fall Finale show, he/she may no longer compete in this medal regardless of eligibility in the other divisions.

SHJG 2'/2'3" EQUITATION MEDAL - open to all riders showing in 2' or higher. Fence height to be determined by trainer. If the rider has won this equitation medal at the 2020 SHJG Fall Finale horse show, he/she may not compete in this medal for 3 years (2021, 2022, 2023).

2021 SHJG Divisions & Classes

MODEL - Open to all riders, horses and ponies. Judged on confirmation and way of going.

SHOWMANSHIP - Open to all riders, horses and ponies. Judged on the handler's presentation of horse/pony to include grooming and show preparation. Handlers may be asked to execute a pattern at the judge's discretion and/or answer horsemanship type questions.

PRE-BEGINNER - open to riders in their first two years of showing. Division will consist of three classes: Walk/Halt Equitation (to be judged on rider), Walk/Trot Equitation (to be judged on rider), Walk/Trot Pleasure (to be judged on mount's suitability as a beginner mount - not movement). Riders may only cross-enter into Beginner Groundrails. Riders may compete in the Beginner Walk/Trot Equitation Challenge.

BEGINNER GROUNDRAILS - open to riders in their first two years of showing. Division will consist of three classes: Groundrails Once Around Tracking Left, Groundrails Once Around Tracking Right, Groundrails Walk/Trot. Riders may cross-enter into EITHER the Pre-Beginner division or the Beginner Flat Division. Riders may compete in the Beginner Walk/Trot Equitation Challenge.

BEGINNER FLAT - open to riders in their first two years of showing. Division will consist of three classes: Walk/Trot Equitation (to be judged on rider), Walk/Trot Pleasure (to be judged on mount's suitability as a beginner mount - not on movement), and Walk/Trot/Canter One at a Time (to be judged on rider). Riders may cross-enter into the Beginner Groundrails division OR the Beginner Crossrails division. Riders may compete in the SHJG Crossrail Equitation Medal and the Beginner Walk/Trot Equitation Challenge or the Beginner Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation Challenge if competing in the Beginner Crossrails.

BEGINNER CROSSRAILS - open to riders in their first two years of showing. Division will consist of three classes: Beginner Crossrails Once Around, Beginner Crossrails Twice Around and Beginner Crossrails Under Saddle (Walk/Trot/Canter). All classes will be judged on the rider's ability to navigate a course of crossrails and the mount's suitability as a beginner mount. Riders may trot and/or canter the crossrails. Simple lead changes will not be penalized. Riders may cross-enter into the Beginner Flat division OR the Crossrail Hunter division. Riders may cross-enter into the Beginner Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation Challenge, Crossrail Equitation Medal and Limit Equitation.

CROSSRAIL HUNTER - open to horses in their first two years of showing and/or riders in their first two years of showing (not counting beginner years). Division will consist of two over fences classes and one under saddle class to be judged as hunter classes. Horses may trot and/or canter courses. Simple lead changes will not be penalized. Riders may cross-enter into Beginner Crossrails OR Mini Hunter. Riders may cross enter into Limit Equitation, the Beginner Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation Challenge and the Crossrail Equitation Medal.

MINI HUNTER - fence height 18" verticals/gates - open to horses in their first two years of showing and/or riders in their first two years of showing (not counting beginner years). Division will consist of two over fences classes and one under saddle class to be judged as hunter classes. Horses may trot and/or canter courses. Simple lead changes will not be penalized. Riders may cross-enter into Crossrail Hunter, Limit Equitation, SHJG Crossrail Medal and the Beginner Walk/Trot/Canter Equitation Challenge.

GREEN HUNTER - fence height 2' with no oxers. Open to horses/ponies in their first two years of showing. Simple lead changes not to be penalized.

LOW HUNTER - fence height 2' with oxers. Open to all horses/ponies.

SCHOOLING HUNTER - fence height 2'3" with oxers. Open to all horses/ponies

SCHOOLING PONY HUNTER - fence height 2'2"6" option. Open to all ponies ridden by a junior.

- Proof of a current negative Coggins test is required to bring horses onto the horse show grounds.
- Any verbal or physical act of discourtesy toward a Judge, Show Official, stall or crew member, on the part of a trainer, owner, rider, groom, family member, or person associated with an entry will immediately disqualify that entry, and all fees will be forfeited
- Correct back numbers must be worn in all classes or the horse/rider may not receive a score; numbers must be worn to enter any ring for warm-up.
- Points cannot be counted for classes completed by fewer than two horses. Related divisions may be combined when entries in one are fewer than six.
- Poling and offsets are absolutely forbidden anywhere on the show grounds.
- All dogs must be on a leash, or otherwise securely contained, at all times while on competition grounds. Said leash must be no more than 6 feet in length, and must be held in hand or secured to an immobile fixture. Retractable leashes must be locked at a length of 6 feet or less. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Loose and/or disruptive dogs may be subject to impoundment by the horse show or by the local government. Owners of loose and/or disruptive dogs may be subject to penalties and/or fines under GHJA Rules 18 and 19. Warning cards may be issued to such dog owners, an accumulation of which shall result in further penalties
- Limited Entries: For the betterment of the show, entries may be closed and/or classes may be limited in number. Please enter early and completely.
- Entry Deadline: Enter online, by fax or by mail postmarked by Wednesday prior to horse show. Only entries submitted online, by mail or fax on an official entry blank will be accepted. Stalls will be reserved only with completed entry blanks. No entries or stall reservations will be accepted by telephone.
- Measurements: pony measurement cards must be presented at check in in order to receive back numbers. Ponies needing measurements will be measured by show management and a member of the steward committee (SHJG shows only).
- SHJG Membership Numbers: In order for points to count toward year-end awards, entry forms must include the horse, owner and rider's SHJG Membership Number.
- Non-members are welcome to show in all classes except the SHJG Medal classes & the SHJG Equitation Challenges.
- All Horses on the Show Grounds: All horses whether showing or not must complete an entry form, pay office and other applicable fees, and riders, when mounted, and wear their assigned back number at all times.
- Champion and Reserve Ribbons will be award in each hunter division, as well as ribbons for 1st through 6th place in each class. Age Group Equitation classes will be pinned to 6th place; no champion & reserve to be awarded.
- The class schedule may be changed for the betterment of the show; Exhibitors agree to show under a substitute judge, should a legitimate need arise.
